# Hand care

- NAILS COURSE …… ¥5,000 60minutes filing, cuticle care, buffing, massage, base, polish (one color), top coat
- PETITE NAIL COURSE ··· ¥3,500 40minutes filing, quick cuticle care, base, polish (one color), top coat
- NAIL CARE COURSE ...... ¥3,500 40minutes filing, cuticle care, buffing, massage
- **DESIGN GEL NAIL** for hand or foot → ¥6,000 filling, cuticle care, design from catalog

## Foot care

- PEDICURE COURSE ········ ¥6,500 60minutes footbath, filing, cuticle care, base, polish (one color), top coat
- PEDICURE GEL ······¥10,000~ filing, cuticle care, gel (one color or more)



### **Notice**

#### About nail polish:

It takes time for the polish to dry (at least 1 to 2 hours).

After having the polish applied, please be careful when shopping in the mall/returning home/etc.

When removing the polish at home, please apply nail polish remover to a piece of cotton and wipe your nail thoroughly.

#### Notice for customers receiving pedicure coloring:

As it takes time for the nail paint to dry, we ask that you come to the salon wearing open sandals.

The colored nail samples on display are not to be attached to your nails. They simply indicate the colors which you can choose from when having polish or gel applied to your nails.

- \* These samples are not for sale.
- For customers who were expecting their nails to be made the same length as the sample.
- \* If you would like your nails lengthened, then this can done as a separate operation for an extra fee

#### **About reservations:**

- \* When making reservations for multiple customers, please specify the number of customers and the desired reservation time for each customer,
- In the case of multiple customers, it may be necessary to separate the reservation times.

#### About the difference between nail gel and nail polish:

Because the nail gel is dried by an led or UV lamp, it can be touched soon after being applied. Although its durability varies from person to person, it generally lasts for 2 to 3 weeks. As nail gel removal is a complicated procedure, we recommend that you have it removed at our salon.

Because the nail polish is air-dried, it should be touched for 1 to 2 hours after application. However, as nail polish removal is a simple procedure, it can be done at home.

#### About the gel:

The gel's durability varies from person to person. As a general rule, we recommend that you have the gel re-applied every 2 or 3 weeks.

When removing the gel, we use a special removal formula. As attempting to remove the gel yourself can result in nail damage, we recommend that you have it removed at our salon.

#### How to remove the nail gel:

- 1. Use a nail file and file down the gel to an appropriate level.
- 2. Apply acetone to a small cotton pad.
- 3. Place the cotton pad on your nail so that the entire nail is covered by the pad.
- **4.** Wrap alumnum foil around your finger so that the pad is held in place on your nail. Leave it like this for 5 to 10 minutes.
- **5**. Remove the foil and pad.
- **6.** Using a special nail gel removal stick, scrape the remaining gel off your nail.
